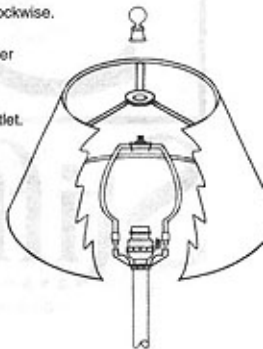

Lamps with Harp Assembly

- 1) Move sleeves up and snap harp into holder.
- 2) Carefully remove plastic covering from shade. All plastic must be removed.
- 3) Place hole of shade around threaded portion of harp.
- 4) Screw on Finial clockwise.
- 5) Screw in the proper wattage light bulb.
- 6) Plug lamp into outlet.

Lamps with Pipe Assembly

- 1) Screw pipe assembly into base assembly.
- 2) Place hole of shade around threaded portion of pipe.
- 3) Screw on Finial clockwise.
- 4) Screw in the proper wattage light bulb.
- 5) Plug lamp into outlet.

Glass Shade Assembly

- 1) Remove shade nut counter clockwise from the socket.
- 2) Place glass shade over socket.
- 3) Screw the shade nut clockwise onto the socket and tighten.

Knock Down Lamp Assembly

- 1) Place base on flat surface
- 2) Screw the bottom column clockwise onto the base. Pull excess wire through bottom of the base.
- 3) Screw the middle column clockwise onto the bottom column. Pull excess wire through bottom of the base.
- 4) Screw the top assembly clockwise onto the middle column. Pull excess wire through bottom of the base.
- 5) Assemble shade as required.
- 6) Screw in the proper wattage light bulb.
- 7) Plug lamp into outlet.
