

BEFORE USING FOR THE FIRST TIME

- 1. Carefully unpack the Blender, Blending Jar, and all parts.
- 2. Wash the Cap, Blending Jar and Blending Jar Lid in warm soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly.
- 3. Make sure the cord is unplugged and the Control Dial is in the (O) OFF position.

CAUTION: To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not place Motor Housing, plug or cord in water or any other liquid.


4. Wipe the Motor Housing clean with a moistened cloth. Dry thoroughly.

BLENDER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Before assembling, make sure the cord is unplugged and the Control Dial is in (O) OFF position.

CAUTION: Use extreme care when handling the Blade Assembly. Do not touch Blades with your fingers. The Blades are very sharp and can cause injury if touched.

- 1. Carefully place the Blending Jar over the Motor Housing by aligning the Arrow with the Unlock Position (see Figure 1.)
- 2. Once Blending Jar is in place, turn counterclockwise until the arrow is aligned with the Lock Position and the Blending Jar locks into place (see Figure 2.)

- 1. Before starting, make sure power cord is unplugged and the Control Dial is in (O) OFF position.
- 2. Make sure that the Blending Jar is securely fastened to the Motor Housing. See Assembly Instructions for details.

CAUTION: Never place the Blade Assembly on the Motor Housing without the Blending Jar being completely assembled and securely tightened.

3. Add ingredients to the Blending Jar and secure the Blending Jar Lid.

NOTE: Do not fill the Blending Jar more than 3/4 full (13-oz.) Never operate when the Blending Jar is empty.

4. Place Blending Jar Lid with Cap on Blending Jar. Remember: Always hold Lid in place during processing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

- 5. Plug the power cord into a 120V AC electrical outlet. Press the Control Switch to ON (--). Blend until ingredients have reached desired consistency.
- CAUTION: If Blending Jar rotates during blending, immediately turn Control Dial to (O) OFF, then secure by turning until the arrow is aligned with the Lock Position and the Blending Jar locks into place as described in the BLENDER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (see Figure 2.)
 - Do not touch Blades
 - Do not interfere with the Blade movement
 - Do not remove Blending Jar Lid
 - 7. When blending is completed, press the Control Switch to (O) OFF to stop the Blender and unplug the unit.

HOT INGREDIENTS

CAUTION: Use extreme caution when blending hot liquids to avoid accidental scalding or burns. Do not use your hand to cover opening!

NOTE: When processing hot foods, always remove the Cap from the Lid before beginning.

- DO NOT put more than 2.5 ounces of hot ingredients into the Blending Jar before beginning to blend.
- After the blending process has begun, you may slowly add up to an additional 2.5 ounces of hot ingredients through the center hole in the Lid.
- Always use a vessel with a pouring spout when adding hot ingredients.

USER MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance requires little maintenance. It contains no user serviceable parts. Do not try to repair it yourself. Any servicing that requires disassembly other than cleaning must be performed by a qualified appliance repair technician.

CAUTION: Never immerse the Motor Housing, plug or cord in water or any other liquid.

- 1. Always unplug the unit before cleaning.
- 2. Whenever possible, rinse parts immediately after processing to make cleanup easier.

- 3. Wash the Blending Jar, Lid, and Cap in warm soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Never use rough scouring pads or abrasive cleansers on any plastic or metal parts as the surface may be damaged. Do not wash the Lid, Cap and Blending Jar in the dishwasher.
- 4. If necessary, wipe exterior surface with a moist cloth or sponge and dry thoroughly.
- 5. Do not fill the Blending Jar with boiling water or place any of the parts in boiling water.
- 6. Do not allow the Blade Assembly to soak in water for long periods of time.
- 7. For quick clean-ups, the interior of the Blending Jar can be cleaned by turning the Blender ON and OFF for several short bursts. The unit will clean itself, without you having to handle the sharp Blades. Unplug the Blender, rinse and dry thoroughly, being careful as the Blades are sharp.
- 8. Properly reassemble all parts before storing.

STORAGE

CAUTION: Always assemble clean and dry Blender parts correctly before storing on the Motor Housing. Severe injury can result if Blender is accidentally turned ON when not properly assembled.

Unplug and clean unit. Store in original box or in a clean, dry place. Never store Blender while it is hot or plugged in. Never wrap cord tightly around the appliance. Never place any stress on cord, especially where the cord enters the unit, as this could cause the cord to fray and break.






Using Your Hot Air Popcorn Popper

NEVER IMMERSE THE POPPER BASE IN WATER OR OTHER LIQUID.

ONLY MELT BUTTER WHILE POPPING KERNELS!

- 1. Before using for the first time, wash popper cover and measuring cup in warm, soapy water; rinse and dry thoroughly.
- 2. Remove popper cover and measuring cup from popper base. Fill the measuring cup to the Max line with kernels and add to popping chamber. Do not fill measuring cup past the Max line Kernels should be level in measuring cup. Measuring cup = 1/2 cup. Never add more than 1/2 cup of popcorn kernels to the popping chamber at one time. Do not put any other ingredients such as oil, shortening, butter, margarine, salt and sugar into popping chamber as damage will occur.
- 3. Place popper cover onto base, positioning bottom edge of cover into groove of base. The measuring cup may be used to melt butter while the unit pops the kernels. If not melting butter, place measuring cup onto popper cover as shown in Figure 1. If melting butter, turn measuring cup over and place inverted onto the popper cover. Never add more than 1/4 cup of butter to the measuring cup. Make sure butter is at room temperature. Cut butter into 8 slices before placing in measuring cup. Note: When using the measuring cup to measure kernels, always wash and dry the measuring cup after each batch of popcorn when melting butter.
- 4. Place a heat-proof popcorn serving bowl under the front of the popper cover. If a plastic bowl is used, be sure it will withstand heat without melting. A metal bowl may become hot to the touch, but it will tend to keep the popcorn warmer.
- 5. Plug unit into a 120V~60 Hz outlet and press the On/Off Switch to On (—).
- 6. Press the On/Off Switch to Off (O) and unplug when popping is complete. DO NOT OPERATE THIS UNIT EMPTY. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MELT BUTTER WITHOUT POPCORN IN CHAMBER. Due to variances in the popcorn type, freshness and moisture content, some popped or unpopped kernels may remain in the chamber after the popping has stopped. To prevent scorching, unplug the popper without waiting for this corn to clear the unit.



CAUTION: AS KERNELS MAY CONTINUE TO POP EVEN AFTER UNIT IS UNPLUGGED, MAKE SURE ALL POPPING HAS STOPPED BEFORE REMOVING COVER.

CAUTION: USE OVEN MITTS WHEN HANDLING HOT SURFACES OF THE UNIT. TO AVOID TEMPORARY MALFORMATION OF THE COVER, ALLOW IT TO COOL ON THE UNIT BASE AFTER POPPING.

7. For additional batches, unplug unit. Make sure the popping chamber is empty. Carefully remove excess popcorn or left over unpopped kernels. Then repeat steps 2 through 6. Note: When popping more than one or two batches of corn, allow the popper to cool down for at least 10 minutes.

Helpful Hints

- This popcorn popper is designed to pop regular and premium brands of popcorn. Try different brands to find the one you like best. Yellow kernels generally pop larger than white. One half cup unpopped kernels will yield approximately 3.5 quarts of popcorn.
- Always use fresh popcorn. Stale or dried-out popcorn pops poorly and may cause scorching or smoking.
- Carefully select the bowl you will be using to collect popped corn.
 A metal bowl may become very hot to the touch due to the flow of hot air from the chute and must be handled carefully. It will, however, tend to keep the popcorn warm. If a plastic bowl is used, be certain it can withstand the heat caused by the warm air flow without melting.
- Never use more than 1/2 cup of kernels per batch.
- Never add salt, sugar or other flavorings into popping chamber.
- This is an AIR corn popper. Popcorn will pop by circulating hot air.
 Oils, fats or shortening are not needed and should never be used.
 Do not use microwave popcorn in this appliance.

How to Clean Your Popcorn Popper

- 1. Unplug and allow unit to cool before cleaning.
- 2. Wash the popper cover and measuring cup in warm, soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Do not wash in dishwasher. Wipe the corn popper base, including the popping chamber, clean and dry with a soft dry cloth. Never immerse the corn popper base in water or other liquid. Do not scour surfaces with steel wool or abrasive cleaners.
- 3. Store fully assembled with cover in place.

Any servicing requiring disassembly other than the above cleaning must be performed by a qualified appliance repair technician.

Cord Storage

Unplug appliance and allow to cool. There is convenient cord storage area on the bottom of the machine. Simply wind the Cord around the Cord Storage area and store in its box or in a clean, dry place.
