- 3. Never drop or insert any object into any opening.



ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- 1. Remove all jewelry before using.
- People who have sensitive skin or have skin reactions to cosmetics or shavers should not use this Trimmer.
- 3. Do not use on areas affected by skin infections, open wounds, sores, varicose veins or skin blemishes.
- 4. Always use on clean dry skin- Remove all make-up before use.
- 5. The Trimmer is for dry use only. Do not use on wet skin. Do not wash the Trimmer with water or rinse under water.
- 6. The Trimmer is for personal use, do not share with others.
- 7. Keep the Trimmer away from the eyes. Do not trim below the eyebrow area. Do not use on Eyelashes.
- 8. Do not use on or inside: underarms, nose canal, ear canal, or other sensitive areas.
- 9. For external use only.
- 10. Always store the Trimmer in a moisture-free area.
- 11. Never operate the Trimmer if it has a damaged Trimmer Blade, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped or damaged. Call Consumer Service for examination or repair. (See Service and Repair in Warranty Section.)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE


Whenever or wherever you need to look your best, The Personal Trimmer is the perfect hair removal tool you can use at home or on the go.

Before Using

The Personal Trimmer is intended for light spot trimming. The Personal Trimmer is not to be used for shaving large amounts of hair.

Installing or Replacing the Battery This product operates on 1 AA 1.5 V Alkaline Battery.

- 1. Slide the Power Switch to the Off position.
- Slide the Battery Cover down the Trimmer's Body to remove. (See Figure 1)
- Align the positive and negative polarity markings to correspond with the guide on the back of the Trimmer in Figure 1.



- 4. Slide the Battery into the Battery Compartment.
- 5. Slide the Battery Cover back up the body until it clicks into place.

Replacing the Battery

- Follow steps 1-2 in the Installing the Battery section, then use your fingertip to gently pry the Battery out of the Battery Compartment.
- 2. Continue with steps 3-4.

Using the Personal Trimmer


- 1. Slide the switch to the On position.
- Hold the Trimmer at a 15 degree angle to your skin, and shave the opposite direction of hair growth.
 Do not use pressure on skin. Use light gentle motions.
- For best results, keep the skin taught by smoothing with your hand as you trim.
- 4. Slide the switch to the off position after each use.

Eyebrow Comb

Attention:

For use on eyebrows only. Use caution around the eye area.

The Eyebrow Combs have three settings detailed in Figure 2. Keep in mind these settings will create very short lengths to create a thin brow.



 Choose the desired setting by using the appropriate Eyebrow Comb.

Tip: The first time using the Eyebrow Comb, it is better to start with the longest setting to see what length works best.

 Decide how close you want the trim by lining up the appropriate letter with the groove on the Trimmer Head. Choose "S" for a shorter, closer cut. Choose "L" for a longer cut. (See Figure 3)



- Slide the track of the desired Eyebrow Comb onto the slot on the Trimmer Head. The Blade should slide in smoothly, otherwise it may be misaligned.
- Slide the Eyebrow Comb all the way down the Trimmer Head until you hear a click. The entire length of the Blade should be covered.
- 5. Once the Eyebrow Comb is in place, slide the switch to the On position and brush the eyebrow with short gentle strokes, starting from the outside of the brow, working your way towards the inside. Angle the Trimmer and Eyebrow Comb upside down and repeat to ensure an even cut. (See Figures 4 and 5)





Suggested Use

Eyebrows

Instead of plucking the eyebrows, trim away excess hairs for a perfectly shaped brow. Can also be used to thin the brow by following the instructions for the Eyebrow Comb.

Sideburns


Section off hair and clip away from area to be trimmed. Move Trimmer in an upward motion stopping just before the clip.

Lip Area

Begin at the lip line and use short upward motions.

Chin Area

To keep the skin taught while trimming, move your bottom jaw forward and smooth out with your hand. Use short gentle motions starting from underneath the chin and moving upward towards the bottom lip.



Bikini Line

With bikini bottoms on, trim any stray hairs that lie on the outside edge of the bikini.



Do not use Trimmer on sensitive areas.

Cleaning and Maintenance

After each use:

Turn the power switch to the Off position.

Use a cleaning brush to remove debris from the Trimmer Blades.

Replace the Protective Cap to protect the Trimmer Blades from damage during storage.

Store the Trimmer in a cool dry place.

Once or twice a month

 With the power switch to the Off position, take a clean cleansing cloth and lightly dampen it with a mild rubbing alcohol or witch hazel. Use this to gently wipe the Trimmer Blades.

Do not use any other cleaning solutions on the Trimmer, this may cause severe skin irritations. Do not use cotton balls, swabs, etc, as the cotton will get stuck in the Blades.

2. Replace the Protective Cap.

Battery Care

- Check that the Batteries are installed correctly – there's a guide on the back of the Trimmer.
- To avoid leakage, check the Batteries regularly for deterioration, remove exhausted Batteries, and remove the Batteries if the Trimmer is not to be used for a long time.
- Discard leaky Batteries immediately. Leaking Batteries can cause skin burns and other personal injuries.
- 4. Dispose of the Battery in compliance with your national or local regulations for environmental protection and recycling of raw materials. Do not dispose of the Battery by burning or incineration.
- When you need new Batteries, change them both. Do not use a new Battery alongside a used one.
- Do not use different kinds of Batteries together (they should both be alkaline).
- Do not try to recharge Batteries unless they're specifically designed to be recharged.

LIMITED 90 DAY WARRANTY

Warranty: This Scünci® product is warranted by Salton, Inc. to be free from defects in materials or workmanship for a period of (90) ninety days from the original purchase date. This product warranty covers only the original consumer purchaser of the product.

Warranty Coverage: This warranty is void if the product has been damaged by accident in shipment, unreasonable use, misuse, neglect, improper service, commercial use, repairs by unauthorized personnel, normal wear and tear, improper assembly, installation or maintenance abuse or other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship. This warranty is effective only if the product is purchased and operated in the USA, and does not extend to any units which have been used in violation of written instructions furnished with the product or to units which have been altered or modified or to damage to products or parts thereof which have had the serial number removed, altered, defaced or rendered illegible.

Implied Warranties: ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES WHICH THE PURCHASER MAY HAVE ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO NINETY (90) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF PURCHASE. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to you.

Warranty Performance: During the above ninety day warranty period, a product with a defect will be either repaired or replaced with a reconditioned comparable model (at our option) when the product is returned to the Repair Center, or the purchase price refunded. The repaired or replacement product will be in warranty for the balance of the one-year warranty period and an additional one-month period. No charge will be made for such repair or replacement.
