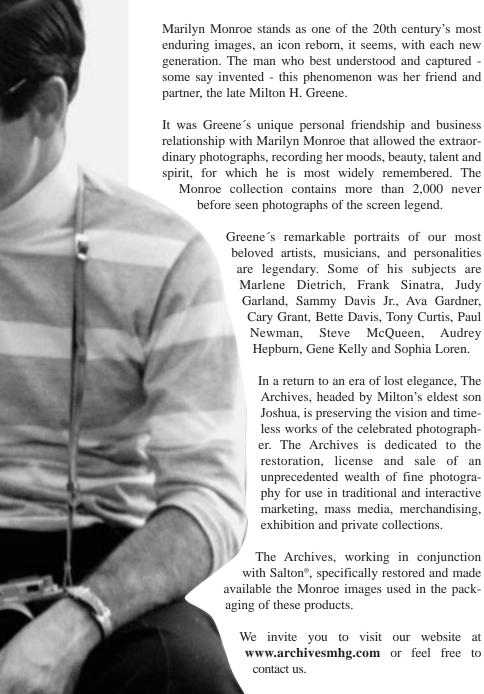

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using this appliance, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

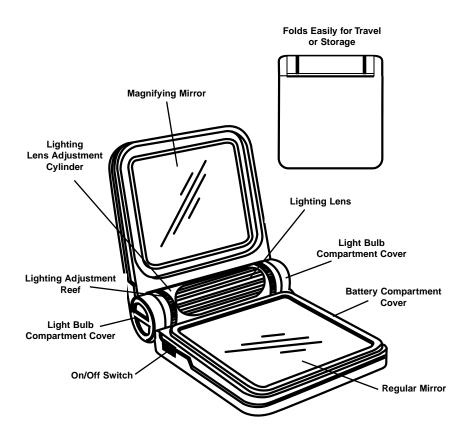
READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING.

- 1. Do not immerse unit in water.
- **2.** Do not expose Mirror to extreme temperatures, such as found near a hot radiator, stove, or in a car parked in the sun.
- **3.** Be sure Mirror is not in a position where it can reflect sunlight. Reflected sun can cause fire.
- **4.** Discard leaky batteries immediately. Leaking batteries can cause skin burns or other personal injury.

GETTING TO KNOW YOUR Salton *Travel Mirror*

Before attempting to use your Salton Travel Mirror, you should become familiar with all of the parts. Read all of the instructions and safeguards carefully.

Identify all parts of your Salton Travel Mirror according to the drawing below, so that you have no doubts when reading the instructions that follow.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Your Salton Travel Mirror is designed specifically for home and travel use. The compact design allows for easy travel and storage.

Please read all instructions carefully and become familiar with all of the parts before using.

INSTALLING BATTERIES

This Mirror requires 4 "AA" Alkaline batteries, which are not included.

To install the batteries, simply slide the Battery Compartment Cover off. The Battery Compartment is found on the side of the Regular Mirror. Note the markings on the inside of the Battery Compartment for correct battery placement.

Slide the Battery Compartment Cover back into place once batteries are secure.

TO USE

To turn on the Light, simply slide the On/Off Switch to ON position.

You may either hold the Mirror or place it on a hard, smooth surface with the Regular or Magnifying Mirror facing you.

To select a light setting, hold the Lighting Lens Adjustment Cylinder with one hand. With the other hand, turn the Lighting Adjustment Reel to select your desired light setting. There are three (3) choices: DAY, OFFICE or EVENING.

Once you have selected a light setting, you may now adjust the Lighting Lens to angle the lighting to your preference. To adjust, simply turn the Lighting Lens Adjustment Cylinder to desired position.

USER MAINTENANCE

Your Travel Mirror requires very little maintenance.

TO CLEAN: The Mirror can be cleaned with any type of window cleaner or glass cleaner. The outside of the unit can be wiped down with a soft, damp cloth or sponge. Do not immerse the Mirror in water or any other liquid.

TO STORE: When storing your Travel Mirror, make sure that it is turned OFF. Fold it and store in its original box or in a cool, dry place. If storing for a long period of time, remove the batteries.

TO REPLACE LIGHT BULBS

- 1. Open the Light Bulb Compartment Cover by rotating counterclockwise and lifting it off.
- 2. Remove the socket and unscrew used light bulbs.
- **3.** Screw new light bulbs into the socket and replace it back into the Light Bulb Compartment.
- 4. Replace the Light Bulb Compartment Cover.

NOTE: The Bulbs required for this mirror are 2 flashlight screw-type 6-volt, 1/2 AMP bulbs. These can be purchased at any hardware store.

ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

This Salton Product warranty extends to the original consumer of the product.

Warranty Duration: This product is warranted to the original consumer purchaser for a period of one (1) year from the original purchase date.

Warranty Coverage: This product is warranted against defective materials or workmanship. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged by accident, in shipment, unreasonable use, misuse, neglect, improper service, commercial use, repairs by unauthorized personnel or other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship. This warranty is effective only if the product is purchased and operated in the USA, and does not extend to any units which have been used in violations of written instructions furnished by Salton, Inc., or to units that have been altered or modified or to damage to products or parts thereof which have had the serial number removed, altered, defaced or rendered illegible.

Warranty Disclaimers: This warranty is in lieu of all warranties expressed or implied and no representative or person is authorized to assume for Salton, Inc. any other liability in connection with the sale of our products. There shall be no claims for defects or failure of performance or product failure under any theory of tort, contract, or commercial law including, but not limited to, negligence, gross negligence, strict liability, breach of warranty and breach of contract.

Warranty Performance: During the above one-year limited warranty period, a product with a defect will be either repaired or replaced with a reconditioned comparable model (at Salton, Inc.'s option), when the product is returned to the Salton, Inc. facility. The repaired or replacement product will be in warranty for the balance of the one year warranty period and an additional one month period. No charge will be made for such repair or replacement.

Service and Repair

Should the appliance malfunction, you should first call toll-free 1-800-233-9054 between the hours of 7:30am and 6:00pm Central Standard Time and ask for Customer Service stating that you are a consumer with a problem.

In-Warranty Service: For an appliance covered under the warranty period, no charge is made for service or postage. Call for a pre-paid return mailing label (U.S. customers only).

Out-of-Warranty Service: A flat rate charge by model is made for out-of-warranty service. Include \$8.00 for return shipping and handling. Salton, Inc. cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage during incoming shipment. For your protection, carefully package the product for shipment and insure it with the carrier. Be sure to enclose the following items with your appliance: any accessories related to your problem; your full return address and day-time phone number; a note describing the problem you experienced; a copy of your sales receipt or other proof of purchase to determine warranty status. C.O.D. shipments cannot be accepted.
