




How to Operate Your Relaxor[®] Stereo Sound Therapy





Inside front compartment

SETTING THE TIME:

Note: The time set and alarm set buttons are located inside the remote control storage compartment area.

To set the time, press and hold the Time "T" button. While holding the Time "T" button, press the Hour "H" button until you reach the correct hour.

Continue to hold the Time "T" button and press the Minute "M" button until you reach the correct minute.

Note: The LCD clock displays the time in standard **AM/PM** mode. The letter "**P**" will appear in the upper left hand corner of the display, indicating "**PM**". It will not show during "**AM**" time. Use it for correct setting of clock and alarm time. The LCD clock display will light up when the AC adaptor is used.

SETTING THE ALARM:

Note: The letter "P" will appear in the upper left hand corner of the clock display, indicating "PM".

To set the alarm, press and hold the "A" button. While holding the "A" button, press "H" button until you reach the desired hour. Continue to hold the "A" button and press the "M" button until you have reached the desired minute.

LISTENING TO NATURE SOUNDS:

Note: The green light on front panel of unit will indicate the selected sound.

1. TO TURN UNIT ON:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button on the unit.

When operating the remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button.

2. TO SELECT ONE OF THE 12 SOOTHING NATURE SOUNDS:

When operating the unit: Press the SOUND SCAN button and select the sound of your choice.

When operating the remote control: Press the SCAN button to select the sound.

3. ADJUST THE TIME SETTING

Switch to desired listening time: 30, 60 or 90 minutes. Slide the timer switch to **CONTINUOUS** for continuous play.

When the timer switch is on **CONTINUOUS**, the sound can be turned off manually by pressing: When operating the unit: Press the **SNOOZE** button. When operating remote control: Press the **PWR/SNZ** button.

4. ADJUST THE VOLUME AS DESIRED:

There are two speakers provided, left and right. Each speaker is controlled by its Volume control. The left speaker has a volume up and volume down control button. Similarly, right speaker has a volume up and volume down control button. This Arrangement

provides better ability for user customization.


When operating the unit: Press the "Volume Up" button on both left side and right side to increase the volume and press "Volume Down" on both left side and right side to decrease the volume.

When operating the remote control: Press "Volume Up" button on left side and right side to increase the volume and press "Volume Down" on left side and right side to decrease the volume.

The dual control is particularly interesting when mixing the sounds of choice. Mixing of sounds is achieved by channeling each sound through an individual speaker. Therefore, one could increase or decrease the volume of one of the selected sounds to create the desired sound effect.



MIXING ANY TWO SOUNDS:

Note: It is recommended that the speakers be adjusted to an even balanced volume for normal use.

TO MIX TWO SOOTHING NATURE SOUNDS:

1. Select the first nature sound:

When operating the unit: Press the SCAN button and select the first sound and then press the MIX button located on top of the unit.

When operating the remote control: Press the SCAN button and select the first sound and then press the MIX button.

2. TO SELECT THE SECOND NATURE SOUND:

When operating the unit: Press the SCAN button and select the second sound and then press the MIX button. You will now hear the mixed sounds.

When operating the remote control: Press the SCAN button and select the second sound and then press the MIX button. You will now hear the mixed sounds.

Note: When the sounds are mixed, you will see two green lights, each representing the selected sounds. Also, the primary sound cannot be chosen twice

3. Adjust the time setting switch to desired listening time: 30, 60 or 90 minutes. Slide the timer switch to **CONTINUOUS** for continuous play.

When the timer switch is on **CONTINUOUS**, the sound can be turned off manually by pressing:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button. When operating remote control: Press PWR/SNZ.

4. Adjust the volume as desired.

TO DELETE MIXED SOUNDS:

5. When you are finished listening:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button. When operating remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button.

When operating the unit: Press the MIX button and the last sound that was selected will be deleted. The previous selected sound will remain on.

When operating the remote control: Press the MIX button and the last sound that was selected will be deleted. The previous selected sound will remain on.

LISTENING TO THE RADIO:

1. For listening to AM/FM radio:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button. Press AM or FM.

When operating the remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button. Press AM or FM.

- 2. Turn the tuning wheel on top of unit for selected AM/FM stations.
- 3. Adjust the time setting switch to desired listening time: 30, 60 or 90 minutes. Slide the timer switch to **CONTINUOUS** for continuous play.

When the timer switch is on **CONTINUOUS**, the radio can be turned off manually by pressing:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button. When operating remote control: Press PWR/SNZ.

For AC Power Use

Connect the receptacle end of the adaptor to the side of the unit marked DC 6V and insert the plug into an electrical outlet.

For Battery Use

1. Battery Insertion For Unit:


To install batteries, remove battery compartment panel on back of unit by pushing down on both latches. Insert 4 C batteries (not included) with the (+) and (-) marks correctly aligned according to diagram shown inside the compartment.


2. Battery Insertion For Clock:

To install one AAA battery (included), open the battery compartment panel on back of unit. Use a phillips screwdriver to remove the inner battery compartment. Insert battery in the proper positive (+) and negative (-) positions according to diagram inside the compartment. After inserting this battery, set clock and alarm.

3. Battery Replacement For Remote Control:

Remove battery compartment in back of unit. Insert batteries according to diagram inside the compartment.






Note: One AAA battery is required at all times to operate the clock. An AAA alkaline battery should last, on the average, one year.

How To Operate Your Relaxor® Stereo Sound Therapy

TO AWAKE TO NATURE SOOTHING SOUNDS

- Turn the unit on by pressing:
 When operating unit: Press the SNOOZE button.
 When operating the remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button.
- Select the sound of your choice (refer to "Listening to Nature Soothing Sounds" Above for operating single or mixed sounds).
- Turn the unit off again by pressing:
 When operating unit: Press the SNOOZE button.
 When operating the remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button.
- 4. Slide the Awake function switch on top of unit to **SOOTHING SOUND ALARM**. The alarm symbol (bell) will appear on the clock face when the alarm is activated.
- 5. When the alarm sounds, slide the Awake function switch to one of the following:

ALARM on unit for the next alarm set time
ALARM on remote control for the next alarm set time
ALARM OFF to turn the alarm off.

Note: The soft sound alarm will go on for approximately 15 seconds and off 20 seconds. It will go on again for 20 seconds and off for 20 seconds. The soft sound alarm will then stay on continuously.

TO AWAKE TO RADIO

- Turn the unit on by pressing:
 When operating unit: Press the SNOOZE button.
 Press AM or FM.
 When operating the remote control:
 Press the PWR/SNZ button. Press AM or FM.
- 2. Turn the tuning wheel to the selected AM/FM station of your choice.
- Turn the unit off again by pressing:
 When operating unit: Press the SNOOZE button.
 When operating the remote control: Press the PWR/SNZ button.
- 4. Slide the Awake function switch on top of unit to RADIO ALARM.

The alarm symbol (bell) will appear on the clock face when the alarm is activated.

- 5. When the alarm sounds, slide the Awake function switch to one of the following:
 - (A) ALARM on unit for the next alarm set time
 - (B) ALARM on remote control for the next alarm set time
 - (C) ALARM OFF to turn the alarm off.

TO AWAKE TO BEEP ALARM

- Slide the Awake function switch on top of unit to BEEPALARM.
 The alarm symbol (bell) will appear on the clock face when the alarm is activated.
- 2. When the beeper comes on, slide the Awake function switch to one of the following:
 - (A) ALARM on unit for the next alarm set time
 - (B) ALARM on remote control for the next alarm set time
 - (C) ALARM OFF to turn the alarm off.

SNOOZE

TO ACTIVATE THE SNOOZE FEATURE:

When operating the unit: Press the SNOOZE button located on top of unit.

When operating the remote control: Press PWR/SNZ.

This will give you an extra 8 minutes of sleep time before the alarm sound again. The **SNOOZE** feature can be used repeatedly to extend your sleep time. To deactivate the **SNOOZE** feature, switch to one of the following:

- (A) ALARM on unit for the next alarm set time
- (B) ALARM on remote control for the next alarm set time
- (C) ALARM OFF to turn the alarm off

MOUNTING UNIT TO THE WALL

To mount unit to the wall, remove from the base and mount the unit using the screws, plastic anchors and mounting guide that are enclosed.
