ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT WHEN USING THIS PRODUCT! THIS IS NOT A TOY!

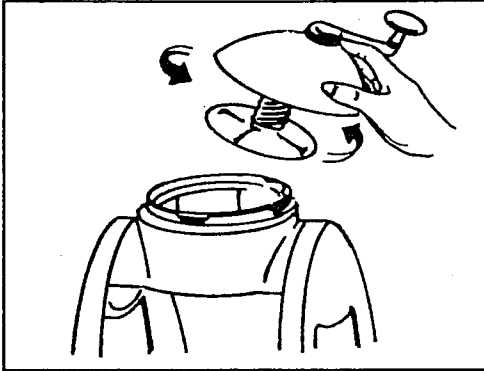

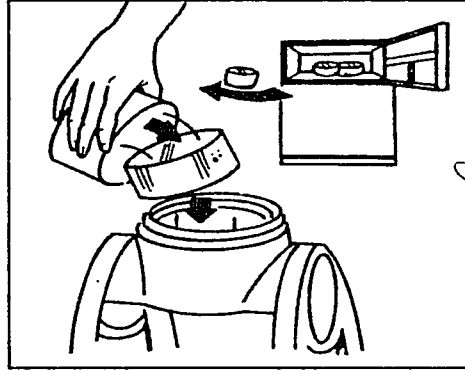
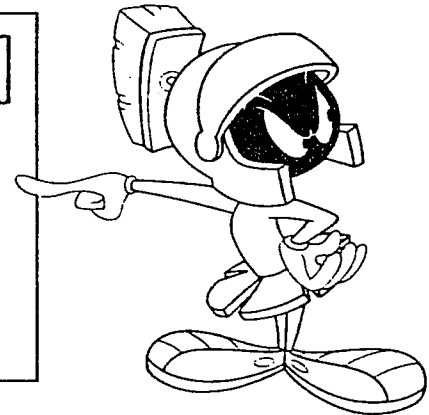

1. Before using the Snow Cone Maker, fill freezer discs with water or other liquid. (See Serving Suggestions for ideas.) When liquid is frozen, you are ready to use the Snow Cone Maker.
2. To open the lid of the Snow Cone Maker, turn it counter-clockwise and pull up. (See Figure 2.)
3. Place the pre-made ice round down into the ice shaving chamber. (Figure 3)

Note: To remove the ice from the freezer disc with ease, run under warm tap water until it begins to loosen from the sides.

Note: If you have not pre-made the ice round, you may use regular ice cubes.

4. Replace the lid by turning clockwise until it is secure.
5. Place the empty freezer disc or small bowl or container underneath the unit to catch the shaved ice.
6. While pressing down gently, turn the handle clockwise to begin the slicing process. (Fig. 4)
7. You may adjust the position of the blade to slice small or large shavings of ice. The more the blade is exposed, the larger the ice shavings will be. The less exposed the blade is, the smaller the ice shavings will be.

*To adjust the blade, simply loosen or tighten the screws located on the bottom of the unit. You will need a Phillips head screw driver. (See Figure 5.) **USE CARE! BLADE IS SHARP!**

**If you are using ice cubes, the blade must be set at a more exposed position.

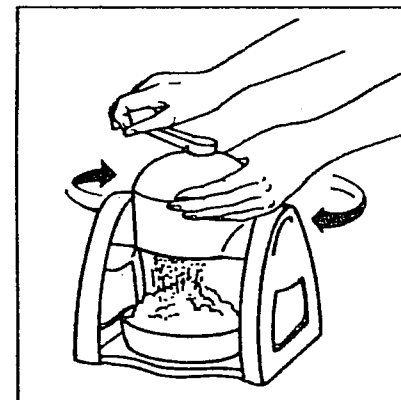

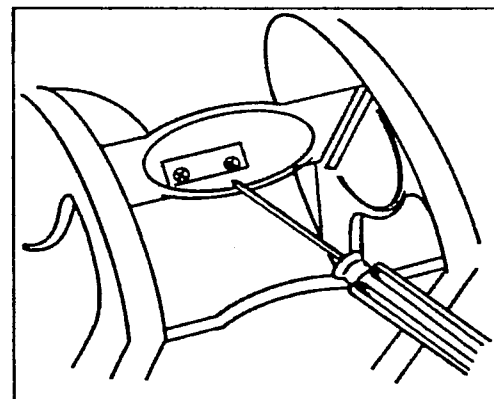

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

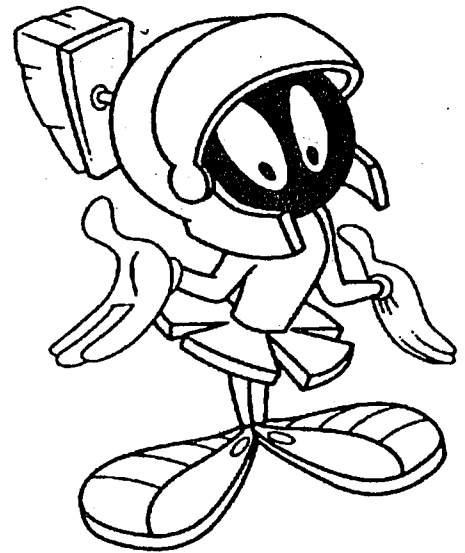
You can make a variety of flavored ices.
Follow these simple instructions:

1. You can freeze water, then shave the ice and add flavored syrup. Flavored syrups can be found in coffee specialty shops, gourmet food stores, and some grocery stores.

When adding the syrup, add one teaspoon at a time until desired taste.

2. Fruit juices, lemonade or other flavored drinks can be frozen in the freezer discs and placed directly in the Snow Cone Maker **for instant flavored ice**. Once it is frozen, then follow the steps explained previously.
3. You may use soft drinks as well. When pouring into the freezer discs, only fill them 1/2 - 3/4 of the way full. This will ensure that the soft drinks will not overflow when frozen. When carbonated beverages freeze they tend to expand.
4. You can use shaved ice to add to frappes or other frozen drinks.
5. Shaved ice can also be used to keep salads, seafood or other food products chilled while on a buffet table. Depending upon the size of the display, place the ice in a larger container than the food to be displayed. Place the tray or bowl of food down into the ice to keep chilled for up to 1 hour.

To serve, put shaved ice in small bowls or in paper Snow Cone cups. Snow Cone cups can be found in most specialty or party shops.



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

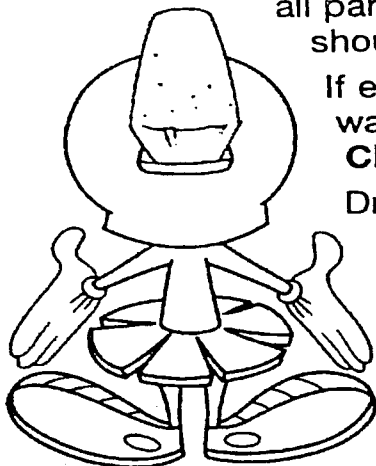
When you have finished using the Snow Cone Maker simply run all parts under warm water. The excess ice and flavorings should just wash away.

If extra cleaning is necessary wash with warm soapy water. **DO NOT USE HARSH ABRASIVES OR CLEANERS.**

Dry all parts thoroughly before storing.

ONE-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Warranty Disclaimers: This warranty is in lieu of all warranties expressed or implied and no representative or person is authorized to assume for Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc. any other liability in connection with the sale of our products. There shall be no claims for defects or failure of performance or product failure under any theory of tort, contract or commercial law including, but not limited to, negligence, gross negligence, strict liability, breach of warranty and breach of contract.

Warranty Performance: During the above one-year warranty period, a product with a defect will be either repaired or replaced with a reconditioned comparable model (at Salton/MAXIM's option) when the product is returned to the Salton/MAXIM facility. The repaired or replacement product will be in warranty for the balance of the one-year warranty period and an additional one-month period. No charge will be made for such repair or replacement.

Service and Repair

Should the appliance malfunction, you should first call toll-free 1-800-233-9054 **between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm Central Standard Time** and ask for CUSTOMER SERVICE stating that you are a consumer with a problem.

In-Warranty Service (USA) for an appliance covered under the warranty period, no charge is made for service or postage. Call for pre-paid return mailing label. (U.S. Customers Only)

In-Warranty Service (Canada) for an appliance covered under the warranty period, no charge is made for service or postage. Please return the product insured, packaged with sufficient protection, and postage and insurance prepaid to the address listed below. Customs duty/brokerage fee, if any, must be paid by the consumer.

Out-of-Warranty Service: A flat rate charge by model is made for out-of-warranty service. Include \$6.00 (U.S.) for return shipping and handling.

Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc. cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage during incoming shipment. For your protection, carefully package the product for shipment and insure it with the carrier. Be sure to enclose the following items with your appliance: any accessories related to your problem; your full return address and daytime phone number; a note describing the problem you experienced; a copy of your sales receipt or other proof of purchase to determine warranty status. C.O.D. shipments cannot be accepted.
