

Important Safety Instructions

- 1. Read all instructions before using.
- 2. Do not immerse in water.
- **3.** Do not position your mirror so that it reflects sunlight. Reflections of sunlight may cause fires.
- 4. Do not expose to extreme temperatures such as found near a hot radiator, stove, or in a car parked in the summer sun.
- 5. Use on a hard, stable, level surface.
- **6.** Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or invalids.
- 7. Discard leaky batteries immediately. Leaking batteries can cause skin burns or other personal injury.
- 8. As with any product containing glass and chemicals, reasonable care should be observed when burned out lamps are discarded. Unbroken lamps should never be put into fire, domestic incinerators or trash compactors.

Save These Instructions

Instructions for Use

- 1. Open the battery compartment and insert 4 "C" size batteries. Be sure that the (+) or cap end of each battery is installed as shown on the inside.
- 2. Replace the battery compartment door.
- **3.** Place the make-up mirror on a hard, stable flat surface. Adjust easel stand to most appropriate position for desired view of your face.
- 4. To activate the lights, simply press the on/off button.

User Maintenance

To keep your make-up mirror in good working condition, be sure to follow these instructions carefully and save them for future reference.

- 1. To clean the outside of the make-up mirror, wipe plastic surfaces with a damp, (not wet) cloth. To clean the mirrors, use a glass or mirror cleaner, with paper towelling or a static-free cloth.
- 2. This product is for household use only. There are no user serviceable parts inside. Any service should be performed by the Salton Service Department.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Machines distributed by Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc. are warranted for one year from date of purchase against defects in workmanship and material. During that period these defects will be repaired or the product will be replaced at Salton/MAXIM's option, without charge. This warranty covers normal consumer usage and does not cover damage which occurs in shipment or failure which results from alteration, accident, misuse, abuse, neglect, installation, commercial use or improper maintenance. This warranty is effective only if the product is purchased and operated in the USA, and does not extend to any units which have been used in violation of written instructions furnished by Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc., or to units which have been altered or modified without authorization of Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc., or to damage to products or parts thereof which have had the serial number removed, altered, defaced or rendered illegible.

Service and Repair

DO NOT attempt to repair your SALTON MM-5 Highlights Make-up Mirror. Should the appliance malfunction, you should first call toll free 1-800-233-9054 between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm Central Standard Time and ask for CONSUMER CUSTOMER SERVICE stating that you are a consumer with a problem. If the problem cannot be resolved, you will be asked to return the machine to the factory for repair. Under no circumstances should you attempt to open the housing and repair the machine. Should you do this, your warranty will be voided.

To Return for Service

- Securely package and return the product, PREPAID to: Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc., Repair Department, 550 Business Center Drive, Mt. Prospect, IL 60056.
- 2. Be sure to enclose:
 - a. Your name, address and phone number.
 - b. The date of purchase (or receipt as a gift).
 - c. An explanation of the malfunction or reason for return.
 - d. Six dollars (\$6.00) Check or Money Order payable To Salton/MAXIM Housewares, Inc. for return postage and handling.
 - e. To insure prompt "In- Warranty" service, be sure to include proof of date of purchase.
